



# Digital Image Service / Image Archive

## Conditions of use

The German Bundestag offers, in the form of its Digital Image Service / Image Archive, an image database allowing users to search for, view and use free of charge for non-commercial purposes topical and historical images of parliamentary events.

Conditions of use pursuant to Section 7 of the Regulations on the Use of the Parliamentary Archives (Annex to the Archive Regulations of the German Bundestag) of 27 June 2008

1. The German Bundestag makes images of parliamentary events available to all via the Digital Image Service / Image Archive. The conditions of use must be accepted in order to access the system.
2. The German Bundestag has acquired all usage rights to the digital images in the Digital Image Service / Image Archive from the copyright holders unless otherwise indicated, e.g. in the information accompanying the images.
3. These images can be downloaded free of charge and used by the Members of the German Bundestag for the purpose of exercising their mandate and by employees of the Members, the parliamentary groups and the Administration of the German Bundestag for official purposes.
4. The images can also be downloaded by anyone and used free of charge for the purpose of reporting on parliament in the following contexts:
  - o Publication in the press,
  - o Publication in print media,
  - o Use in film and on television, and
  - o Online and multimedia publications.

They may also be used for private, non-commercial purposes and for non-commercial purposes relating to civic education. Any other use for commercial purposes, in particular for advertising purposes, is prohibited.

5. The information accompanying the images and the usage restrictions contained therein must be complied with. The user is liable for damages resulting from non-compliance. In this respect, the user indemnifies the German Bundestag against claims by third parties.
6. The user must delete the digital images downloaded from the Digital Image Service / Image Archive after use without delay. Images may not be saved electronically for archival purposes or passed on to third parties.
7. Any editing, alteration or manipulation of the digital images from the Digital Image Service / Image Archive, other than colour correction, cropping and resizing, is permissible only with the prior written consent of the German Bundestag. Equally, a digital image downloaded from the Digital Image Service / Image Archive may not be reproduced out of context.
8. Any distortion of the copyright-protected work, in image, text or any other form, e.g. by means of rephotography, falsification, photocomposition or using electronic tools, is prohibited. The user is responsible for the caption.
9. The media are, in particular, obliged to comply with the journalistic principles of the German Press Council (Press Code). Permission to use the images does not imply that the persons pictured, the holders of the rights to works pictured or of trademarks or other property rights have given their consent to public reproduction. The user is responsible for obtaining the consent of third parties necessary in individual cases. The user must respect the personal rights, copyright, trademarks and other property rights of the persons, works, objects or signs pictured. If such rights are not respected, the user alone is liable to third parties.
10. When using a digital image downloaded from the Digital Image Service / Digital Archive, the source "German Bundestag / name of photographer or name of agency" must be cited. This also applies in the case of electronic publications such as Internet sites, for example. The German Bundestag reserves the right to require that more extensive information be given.
